# Getting Specialty Care With Your OMNIA<sup>SM</sup> Health Plan



**A specialist is a doctor who “specializes” in taking care of a particular bodily system or disease. Cardiologists (heart care) and oncologists (cancer care) are two common types, but there are many more kinds of specialists.**

**With your OMNIA Health Plan, you do not need a referral to see an in-network specialist.** However, you may need prior authorization for certain specialty services before you receive them.

“Prior authorization” means that Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Jersey must approve certain specialty services before you receive them. Without proper authorization, you might receive services that are not covered by your plan, leaving you responsible for the total cost.

Remember, you will pay less out of your pocket when your care is delivered by OMNIA Tier 1-designated doctors, hospitals and other health care professionals.

Services provided by doctors, hospitals and other health care professionals who are not in the Horizon Managed Care Network or the Horizon Hospital Network are not covered. You’ll be responsible for the total cost of any out-of-network services you receive (except in the case of an emergency).

You can refine your search by entering a ZIP code or other criteria.
